1. Paragraph 3, General Orders No. 26, these Headquarters, dated Denver, Colorado, November 16, 1921, is amended by adding the following sub-paragraph:

3.-a. * * *.

b. Under the provisions of Section 3A of the National Defense Act, the 1st Infantry, Colorado National Guard, which served during the World War as part of the 157th Infantry, and which was disbanded at Fort D. A. Russell, Wyoming, April 29, 1919, is hereby reconstituted and consolidated with the 157th Infantry, Colorado National Guard.

2. Paragraph 1, Special Orders No. 4, these Headquarters, dated Denver, Colorado, January 21, 1922, is amended by adding the following sub-paragraph:

1.-a. * * *.

b. Under the provisions of Section 3A of the National Defense Act, as amended, the 1st Cavalry, Colorado National Guard, which served during the World War as part of the 157th Infantry, and which was disbanded at Fort D. A. Russell, Wyoming, April 29, 1919, is hereby reconstituted and consolidated with the 117th Cavalry, Colorado National Guard.
