Today is the fifth of June— <i>hal-</i> <i>YOM KHAM-sa ho-zay-</i> <i>RAHN</i>	What do you want?— <i>shit-REED</i>
What day of the week?— <i>hal-</i> <i>YOM SHI-nu</i>	Bring some drinking water— <i>JEEB MAI li-SHU-rub</i>
Today is Tuesday, etc.— <i>hal-</i> <i>YOM ith-tha-la-THAA</i>	Bring some food— <i>JEEB</i> <i>SHWAY-yat A-kil</i>
Come here— <i>ta-'AAL hi-NAA</i>	How far is the camp?— <i>shgad</i> <i>bi-'EED il-ma-'AS-ka</i>
Come quickly— <i>ta-'AAL bil-'A-</i> <i>jal</i>	How far is the water?— <i>shgad</i> <i>bi-'EED il-MAI</i>
Go quickly— <i>ROOh bil-'A-jal</i>	Whose house is this?— <i>BAYT</i> <i>man HAA-dha</i>
