

IMPORTANT NOTICE MEMORANDUM TO RESERVE OFFICERS REFERENCE

FORM 778, A.G.O.

1. Form 778 A.G.O., is your Annual Registration with the War Department.
2. It can be filled out, signed, blotted, placed in envelope and envelope sealed, in two minutes. The time for mailing depends on the distance to the nearest mail box and your promptness in mailing.
3. A number of officers did not submit the Form last year; We are relying on you to submit yours again this year, NOW.
4. Please fill in ALL SPACES and be brief but definite.
5. If you are in, or have been in, the National Guard since July 1, 1925, give National Guard status pertaining thereto under REMARKS.
6. If the permanent address given by you on the Form is within the Corps Area but different from that of record or is outside the Corps Area, your records will, if they have not already been, be transferred to your new Corps Area Commander, or new Chief of Staff, C.R., as the case may be, and you need not submit Form 649-R.
7. DON'T send the Form to The Adjutant General at Washington, send it to the headquarters whose address is on the enclosed envelope.
8. Please indicate under "Remarks" whether or not you consent to assignment to a unit in the Regular Army. Such an assignment simply means that, in the event of a national emergency you would report for duty to the Regular Army unit and serve with it, in the same manner you would be mobilized with and serve in, a reserve unit to which assigned.
